



PIESCAPE

A few miles outside the township of Cooma, at the foot of the Snowy Mountains, is an old time wrecking yard called Flynn's. The day I walked around Flynn's sketching, taking photos & eating the beautiful pies just purchased fresh from the bakery at Jindabyne was cold & overcast. I scrambled between rows of old Fords, Holdens & early Kombis, many with the signwriting of local merchants fading away on their panels. Birds of all descriptions had taken up refuge in many of the wrecks, none more prolific than the Magpies who seemed to be the keepers of the old yard.

"Piescape" is mostly the result of my visit to Flynn's at Cooma, but it also has a little to do with the great pies I have when I visit the snow country & Sundance Bakery.
